

IIM Amritsar conducted the seventh annual HR conclave - YUKTI on the 5th of August, 2023, The conclave kicked off with a keynote address from Mr. Raj Raghavan, Chief People Officer Corestack.io. Culture He and discussed the challenges brought about by the COVID era, the evolving role of HR due to AI, and the importance of human intervention in AI to address issues like bias. He highlighted Al's use cases in recruiting and career pathing, while acknowledging concerns about job redundancy. The address was followed by an enlightening discussion from a panel of experts on the topic "Impact of AI on HR: Opportunities and Challenges".





Mr. Paneesh Rao, the moderator, delved into Al's potential to replace the human factor in HR and its impact on empathy and inclusivity. Ms. Sunita Rebecca Cherian shared insights Wipro, emphasizing technology's from empowerment of employees and the need for human touch in recruitment. Mr. Rahul Bagale discussed AI's limitations and opportunities, stressing the importance of people in HR. Mr. Abhay Kapoor explored AI's role in talent acquisition during the pandemic, and Mr. Ahluwalia highlighted Al's Gaurav effectiveness in sourcing candidates.

The panel's insights were extremely valuable understanding the role, importance, opportunities, and threats that AI has in the HR field. The panelists also addressed the questions in a Q&A session students' afterward.

Mr. Wagh stressed the importance of leadership involvement in addressing organizational issues, particularly mental health, and commended IIM Amritsar students for organizing the event.





EKAGRA 6.0
